

Information for Authors
concerning copyright to works published in the journal titled
“Scientific Bulletin of the Administrative Courts”

I.

For works commissioned by the Publisher, the Author shall transfer onto the Publisher – the moment the work is provided – the economic copyright to the work for an indefinite time, without territorial restrictions, within the contractual fields of exploitation, including in particular the right to temporarily or permanently record and reproduce the work in part or in full, using any means and in any form, including printing, reprography, magnetic recording or digital techniques, such as a recording the work using CD, DVD, Blu-Ray, flash disk, or any other media, especially when entering into computer memory; as well as the right to distribute the work in part or in full, individually or as part of collections issued by the Publisher, in particular within the framework of the journal titled “Scientific Bulletin of the Administrative Courts”, including in such a way that anyone may access it in part or in full at the time and in the place of their own choice, especially through open access via publicly available computer networks (Internet), restricted-access networks, i.e., on the Publisher’s websites, and information portals of the press house that cooperates with the Publisher under the terms and conditions specified in the agreement concluded between the Publisher and the press house.

As regards the contractual fields of exploitation, the Publisher may distribute the work, but has no obligation to do so. Insofar as legally admissible, the Author’s right to withdraw from the agreement if the Publisher decides not to distribute the work, shall be excluded.

II.

For other works, the Author shall grant the Publisher – the moment the agreement is signed – a non-exclusive, perpetual and worldwide license to use the work within the contractual fields of exploitation, including in particular the right to temporarily or permanently record, reproduce and distribute the work on the terms and conditions specified hereinabove.

Within the framework of the license granted, the Publisher may sub-license the work in part or in full to be used individually or as part of collections issued by the Publisher under Creative Commons Attribution – NonCommercial – NoDerivatives (CC BY-NC-ND) 4.0 or a newer version of this license published by Creative Commons. The Author may revoke the license – the notice period being five years effective as at the end of the calendar year – with the proviso that the statement of revocation may be made only five years after the license commencement date.

After the license expires, the work may still be distributed in part or in full, individually or as part of collections issued by the Publisher, using those distribution platforms on which it was placed within the duration of the license, including the Creative Commons license.

The Author consents for the Publisher to distribute the work in part or in full to be used individually or as part of collections also after the license expires, on the condition that this is done within the framework of open access arising from the Creative Commons license.
