

## **Ghostwriting / guest authorship firewall**

The editorial board of “Zeszyty Naukowe Sądownictwa Administracyjnego”, seeking for the high quality of the ZNSA journal and in order to ensure academic integrity, has introduced a procedure to prevent illegal practices, such as ghostwriting and guest authorship.

The authors of papers submitted to the ZNSA are required to provide the author's declaration on the transfer of a publishing license. The statement includes a ghostwriting and guest authorship declaration. The author represents that he or she holds any copyrights to the paper submitted and specifies the contribution of third parties in the process of preparing the paper, including co-authors specified by their names, as well as discloses any sources of financing, contribution of research and academic institutions, associations and other entities, if the paper is a result of a research project.

**A signed declaration should be sent to the editorial board together with the paper.** Failure to submit the declaration prevents the publication of the paper in the ZNSA journal.

Papers published in the journal are verified in terms of their originality. Any cases of academic dishonesty will be disclosed by the editorial board, and information thereon will be shared with institutions employing the author or academic societies.
